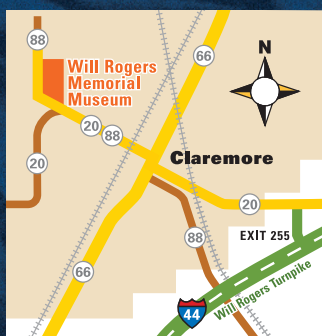


Will Rogers Memorial Museum

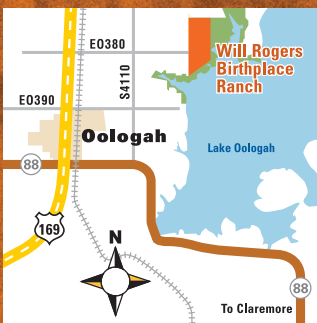
